REQUIRED MATERIALS: Application Form, Cover Letter, Transcript, Resume, Writing Sample (5-10 pages of original written work) all in portable document format (PDF).

Selection Criteria: Interest in and commitment to environmental law; year of study (Spring 2013 grads given priority); lack of conflicts of interest; ability to successfully complete course requirements.

Pre-Requisites/Co-Requisites: Environmental Law, Administrative Law and Environmental Litigation (may be waived in unusual circumstances).

Your Commitment: 2-hour class each week with student presentations (Fridays from noon until 2pm); meet with supervising attorney regularly (usually once a week); 8-10 hours of independent work per week.
