- Environmental and Natural Resources Law focus:
 Two weeks/four credits of environmental and natural resources law courses.
- Environmental and Natural Resources Law and U.S. Law Practice focus: Two weeks/ four credits of environmental and natural resources law courses, plus a two week placement with law firm and opportunities to meet with judges and observe court proceedings.

Tuition

Tuition for the entire program is \$5000 for the **Environmental and Natural Resources Law** focus option, and \$10,000 for the

Environmental and Natural Resources Law and U.S. Law Practice option. This includes course fees, textbooks and course materials. Tuition does not include airfare, housing, meals, or other living or travel expenses.

Housing

A limited number of rooms in the Lewis and Clark dormitories will be reserved and made available to summer participants. Additional housing is available in nearby hotels.
