## International Advocates Animal Law LL.M. Scholarships

The Center for Animal Law Studies (CALS) is pleased to announce its 2016-2017 Animal Law LL.M. Scholarships for individuals with extraordinary ability and potential in the field of animal law. The Scholarship is designed to support scholars who demonstrate exceptional potential and interest in obtaining an education to become their countries' innovators and leaders in legal work such as protecting wildlife or prosecuting animal cruelty.

Our scholarships include:

- Full waiver of tuition
- On-campus student housing with a partial meal-plan for the academic year
- Health insurance
- One round-trip international airline ticket

The scholarships do not cover additional course costs, such as books or other activities. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, financial need, and the applicant's personal statement in response to questions detailed in the application.

## Interested in Applying?

To be eligible, applicants must first meet the admission criteria and be admitted to the Animal Law LL.M. Program.

Applicants must demonstrate a sincere interest and/or relevant experience in animal law or related areas. Preference will be given to qualified applicants from African countries, but all international candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.
