- - From undergrad campus what they're doing for health and wellness
  - Focus on Mental Health
  - What level of care should campuses be providing and when should students be referred off-campus?
    - Donor money disappearing = lowering staff = changes expected
    - Fall peak waiting list was 28 students; max wait 1 month
    - Emergency criteria modified scheduled 1-2 days out
    - Don't think request from institution to replace funds will be successful
    - Do nothing = longer wait times
    - Alternatives: Implement "wellness fee" for undergrad (use the most services) semester-based fee for wellness service:
  - What's going on in the law school realm?
    - % of students being treated for mental health issues & considering suicide have increased
    - number of cases & appointments has increased 50% since 2009
    - increase in the seriousness/acuity of the problems as well
    - What will the law school do?
      - + Currently only use about 10% of services
      - + Option: hire staff member 50% of their time for law students \$38 per student per semester
      - + Resources issue
      - + Services follow the money want it to be more accessible for our campus (have the counselor here on our campus)
