Designed to teach students with no prior background in trade or environmental law, this book is equally accessible to students and professors from both civil and common law jurisdictions. Opening chapters present key trade and environmental policy theories and concepts, and introduce the structure of the World Trade Organization (WTO) and its process for adjudicating trade disputes. Substantive chapters assess the GATT's core obligations and the "general exceptions" to those obligations for certain types of environmental measures.
