Goulden, *Some Chancery Lawsuits 1714-1758: An Analytical List* (rev. ed. 1983), which collected the locations of numerous pleadings in Chancery relating to the book trade, and to Joyce Helene Brodowski, *Literary Piracy in England from the Restoration to the Early Eighteenth Century 339-46* (1973), which covered an earlier period and included references not only to pleadings but to orders and decrees as well. I also used Roman Deazley's *On the Origin of the Right to Copy* (2004) as a starting point for other cases.
