Costs and Financial Aid

Summer 2019 tuition to be determined at the end of February 2019. Tuition is charged per credit-hour for law students and auditors wishing to receive an auditing certificate.

Visiting law students should apply for financial aid through their home institutions. No financial aid is available for auditing students.

Auditing Attorneys and others interested in summer courses may audit a course if there is space available and the instructor consents. A Bachelor's degree is required to audit. Auditors who wish to receive a certificate of course completion must pass the final exam. Those auditors who do not take the final exam do not receive a certificate. They are deemed "non-certificate" students and pay less tuition for the course. CLE credit may be available for attorneys who audit a course. In no case will a transcript be issued for auditors.
