- Participating in interactive course moments
- Practicing self-care
- Respectfully limiting use of technology, including cell phones, during sessions
- Completing three brief Post-Academy questionnaires

THE BASIC ACADEMY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Creating and implementing a curriculum focused on core advocacy competencies
- Ensuring that the curriculum integrates effective adult learning methods
- Selecting, preparing and assisting faculty in providing high quality instruction and facilitation
- Addressing all topics necessary for the National Advocate Credentialing Program
- Facilitating Post-Basic Academy opportunities for graduates to continue learning, community building and professional development
- Respectfully interacting with faculty, facilitators, attendees and graduates
- Respecting the privacy of attendees, graduates, faculty and facilitators
- Responding to attendee, graduate, faculty and facilitator feedback
