



2022 Student Registration Instructions

Student registration for the NW Public Service Career Fair opens on Friday, November 19th, 2021. The NW Public Service Career Fair takes place on Friday, February 4th and Saturday, February 5th, 2022. The fair is virtual, and one registration allows you to access both days of the fair. You must be a student or alumni of a NW Consortium law school to attend the fair. There is no cost to attend.

Registration is a two-step process and must be completed in order.

Step 1: Register on Eventbrite [here](#).

You must register with your official school email address (@lclark.edu, @seattleu.edu, @law.byu.edu, etc.) on Eventbrite. If you use another email address, you will be deregistered and unable to complete the next step.

By completing this step, you will receive information about and access to Table Talks.

Step 2 (Optional): Apply for Jobs. Applications are due January 19, 2022 at Noon.

Your second step will be determined by the school that you attend. Both fairs this year will manage applications through Career Connect. If you do not plan to apply for positions or interview, and you are only planning to attend Table Talks, you do not need to complete this step.

For students who attend Lewis & Clark Law School:

To view participating employers and to submit applications for interviews, log in to your Career Connect account, select “OCI and Job Listings” from the left-hand menu, and apply to jobs listed under the “2022 NW Public Service Career Fair” OCI.

For students who attend other law schools in the NW Consortium:

You will need to apply for a Career Connect account before you can apply to jobs. To do so, send an email from your official school email address to lscs@lclark.edu with the subject line “NWPSCF - Need Career Connect Account.” Be sure to include your full name and graduation year (“1L – 2024”). Lewis & Clark will confirm you have registered for the Eventbrite event before granting your account. If you do not receive an email to claim your account within 48 business hours of your request, please let us know.

Once you have an account, select “OCI and Job Listings” from the left-hand menu, and apply to jobs listed under the “2022 NW Public Service Career Fair” OCI.
