## **Endowed Chair, Professorship, or Faculty Scholar**

Endowed faculty positions are academic honors that showcase the significance of criminal justice studies and recognize excellence in teaching. You can endow a Criminal Law Chair with a gift of \$2 million or more for existing positions or \$3 million or more for new positions. a professorship with a gift of \$1 million or more, and a faculty scholar with a gift of \$500,000 or more.

Named Scholarships Support students who demonstrate a commitment to work in criminal justice by creating an annual or endowed named scholarship with a recommended investment of \$100,000 (\$50,000 minimum for endowed, \$30,000 minimum for annual) or contributing directly to an existing named scholarship.
