Our Animal Law LLM —offered in-person and online—is designed for U.S. and international law school graduates who desire to focus on animal law in practice, teaching, research or public policy. Our commitment is to educate and train students to become leaders in animal law and experts in the field. We offer the most extensive animal law curriculum in the world, along with opportunities to take advantage of the many other benefits of the animal law community at Lewis & Clark Law School.

## Career Pathways

Paving career pathways for our Animal Law advanced degree alumni starts with career counseling while they are in the Animal Law Program. We support our alumni's efforts through our Global Ambassador Program and by facilitating opportunities like being invited as conference speakers, supporting their work through microgrants, and helping alumni network within the animal protection community. Our alumni are making a difference for animals in an array of areas, including: animal protection, facilitating development of the field of animal law, outreach, academic scholarship and more.




## Advanced Learning

In addition to offering the world's most robust animal law course offerings, CALS also offers multiple experiential learning opportunities for in-person LLM students, such as:

- **Animal Law Clinic:** Serves as a comprehensive training ground for students interested in the full range of policy and related work to benefit the field of animal law. It encourages consideration of the interests of animals in legal decision-making through the direct representation of clients.
- **Farmed Animal Protection Project:** Concentrates on farmed animal protection (both terrestrial and aquatic animals) and lawyering skills used by advocates. Students also create an individual project in the field of farmed animal protection law that is shared with the public at the end of the academic year.
- **Global Law Alliance for Animals and the Environment:** A collaboration with our nationally recognized Environmental Law Program that provides students with the opportunity to work on overlapping areas of animal law and environmental law, such as wildlife, climate change, and more.
