Career Pathways

Paving career pathways for our Animal Law LLM alumni starts while they are in the Animal Law program. We support our alumni's efforts through our Global Ambassador Program and by facilitating opportunities like being invited as speakers at conferences, supporting animal law work through microgrants, and helping them develop innovative approaches to animal protection. Our LLM alumni are making a difference for animals around the world in an array of areas, including: animal protection, facilitating development of the field of animal law, outreach, academic scholarship and more.



Advanced Learning

In addition to traditional coursework, CALS offers multiple clinics and experiential learning opportunities for in-person LLM students, such as:

- **Farmed Animal Protection Project** - Concentrates on farmed animal protection and lawyering skills used by farmed animal protection legal advocates. In-class exercises teach farmed animal protection legal strategies and lawyering skills and students create an individual project in the field of farmed animal protection law.
- **International Wildlife Law Clinic** - A collaboration with our nationally recognized Environmental Law program providing the opportunity to work on overlapping areas of animal law and environmental law, such as wildlife, climate change, and more.
