Career Pathways

Paving career pathways for our Animal Law advanced degree alumni starts with career counseling while they are in the Animal Law Program. Advanced Learning

In addition to offering the world's most robust animal law courses, CALS also offers experiential learning opportunities for in-person MSL students, such as:

- **Farmed Animal Protection Project** concentrates on farmed animal protection (both terrestrial and aquatic animals) and advocacy skills used by farmed animal protection legal advocates. Students also create an individual project in the field of farmed animal protection law that is shared with the public at the end of the academic year.
