







Distribution of property ratings




Average rent by apartment size







Portland has 5 (yes, 5!) quadrants: N, NE, NW, SE, and SW. The city is divided north and south by Burnside Street and the Willamette River divides the east and west.



1 Lake Oswego

30% of Lewis & Clark Law Students

Lake Oswego is a suburb south of campus. It's a quiet and safe neighborhood with plenty of nearby parks and trails. The commute to class is very manageable if you have a car.

3 Downtown Portland

20% of Lewis & Clark Law Students

Rents Downtown tend to be more expensive, especially near the Pearl District. However, a potential upside is that Lewis & Clark offers a free shuttle from one central stop downtown to campus throughout the day.

2 SW Portland

20% of Lewis & Clark Law Students

Southwest Portland is the area generally southwest of Downtown Portland and is where Lewis & Clark Law School is located. It includes the smaller neighborhoods of Multnomah Village, Hillsdale, and John's Landing.

4 Northwest Industrial

20% of Lewis & Clark Law Students

Northwest Portland offers a diverse selection of price ranges and housing types (houses, new apartment complexes and condominiums). There are several bars and restaurants nearby and easy access to Downtown.

ABOUT LAKE OSWEGO



ABOUT SW PORTLAND



Townhouses

Smaller properties and how to find them

ABOUT TOWNHOUSES

Townhouses are apartments in older buildings, typically a few stories tall. They usually do not have a doorman, an elevator, or many amenities, but can be cheaper and more spacious than the apartment and condo units in high-rises.

Finding a townhouse

Townhouses can be challenging to find because they tend to be individually owned and do not have full time leasing managers. Townhouse listings are typically available ~60 days in advance. You can find a townhouse by searching online listings, contacting a landlord directly, or by working with VeryApt's Concierge Team who can help identify some options.

Preparing for a townhouse search

Most Lewis & Clark Law students opt for larger properties in order to live closer to other students and simplify the housing search. That said, there are plenty of wonderful townhouses - be prepared to visit more properties to find that perfect home, carefully examine the pros/cons, and move quickly if you find a unit you love.

TIPS AND ADVICE



Reliable Landlords

Check online reviews and talk to previous tenants to find out about your landlord. Look for one that responds quickly to maintenance requests and has a history of returning deposits.



Noise and Neighbors

Sounds often travel well through townhouses and you can easily be disturbed by barking dogs, music, or construction. Check out the surrounding area to get a sense for what it may be like.



Lease Terms

Leases with independent landlords are negotiable. Check your lease for restrictions on sub-letters and visitor policies. You may be able to avoid a rent increase by locking in a longer lease.
