Costs and Financial Aid

Summer 2026 tuition is \$2,359.00 per credit hour. Law students and auditors will be charged by the credit hour at the summer tuition rate.

Visiting law students should apply for financial aid through their home institutions. No financial aid is available for auditors.

Auditing Attorneys and others interested in summer courses may audit a course if there is space available and the instructor consents. A Bachelor's degree is required to audit. Auditors who wish to receive a certificate of course completion must pass the final exam. Those auditors who do not take the final exam do not receive a certificate. They are deemed "non-certificate" auditors and pay less tuition for the course. CLE credit may be available for attorneys who audit a course. In no case will a transcript be issued for auditors.
