- All entrants will be invited to attend the Sixth World Conference on Nonsmokers' Rights in Washington, DC, held June 12-13, 2010 at the GWU Law School in Washington, DC.
- Participants at the Conference will learn about job opportunities in this new and expanding area (in part because of two new pieces of legislation), and network with practitioners.
- Winners will be selected only after an oral presentation, and an opportunity to respond to questions. It's not just a writing contest, but rather a creativity and advocacy competition.
- Many of the entries—including all 30 finalists—will be published on the Internet where they can be found, cited to, and read by prospective employers and others.
