



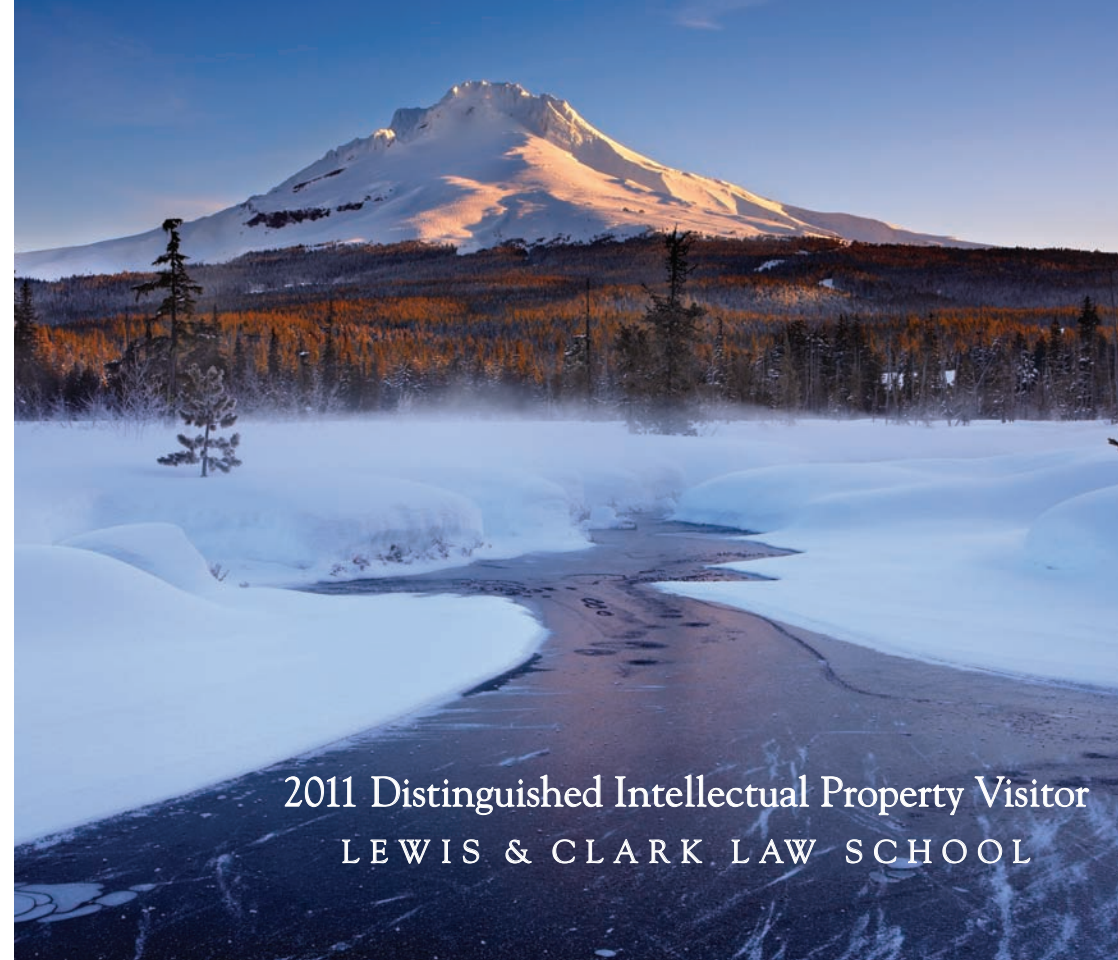

**JUDGE WILLIAM C. BRYSON** has served on the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit Court for over 15 years. In recent years he has authored some of the most significant opinions of the court, including *Phillips v. AWH Corp.*, *Egyptian Goddess, Inc. v. Swisa, Inc.*, *In re Katz Interactive Call Processing Patent Litigation*, and *LizardTech, Inc. v. Earth Resource Mapping, Inc.* Prior to

his appointment to the Federal Circuit in 1994, Judge Bryson was with the United States Department of Justice, serving as an Assistant to the Solicitor General [1978-79], Chief of the Appellate Section of the Criminal Division [1979-83], Counsel to the Organized Crime and Racketeering Section [1983-86], Deputy Solicitor General [1986-94], Acting Solicitor General [1989 and 1993], and Acting Associate Attorney General [1994]. Judge Bryson served as Law Clerk to the Honorable Henry J. Friendly, United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit from 1973 to 1974, and as Law Clerk to the Honorable Thurgood Marshall, Supreme Court of the United States, from 1974 to 1975. Judge Bryson received an A.B. from Harvard College in 1969 and a J.D. from the University of Texas School of Law in 1973.
